WE ARE COMPLETE... we have extra club room.. and we have storage. We will be removing all safes, gun racks, cleaning machines from the range. We have a two-step plan to improve air flow on our range:

- 1. remove all the safes, cleaning machine, boxes and any extra moveable items.**

2. build a hollow core back wall and use the wall to inject an air wall towards the shooters.

We will be applying for an Engineering Grant from the City Parks to study the most efficient way to undertake this continuing project. Our goal has always focused on the best air movement for our members.
